

Transfers

The District is required to advise parents and guardians of statutory attendance options and local attendance options available in the District. (EC48980(h)). These are options for attending schools other than the one assigned by the District.

At Victor Elementary School District, enrollment is based on quadrants. The District is divided into four quadrants – two quadrants on each side of the 15 freeway. The quadrants are geographic regions comprised of 3-5 VESD schools. This format allows families the opportunity to select school(s) that best suit their child(ren)'s interests. There are 3-5 options available in each quadrant, and, bussing is provided.

INTRA-DISTRICT TRANSFERS

Students who attend schools outside of their quadrant are welcome to enroll within other quadrants. Due to growth, class size limits, and school capacity, it may not be possible to approve all enrollment requests. Requests are granted based on space availability. Each spring, enrollment packets are accepted at all schools. If a school is at capacity within a quadrant, a lottery process is conducted to provide equity for all interested families. After space availability is determined, parents will be notified. Transportation is the responsibility of the parent and/or guardian.

INTER-DISTRICT TRANSFERS

Inter-district transfer requests from districts outside the boundaries of Victor Elementary School District require a release from the district in which the student resides (home district). The parent or legal guardian of a pupil may seek release from the home district to attend a school in any other school district. Transfers will be approved only if space is available.

If you live within the Victor Elementary School District's boundaries and would like to attend another school district, you may obtain an inter-district transfer form from the Pupil Services Department, located at the District office at 12219 2nd Avenue, Victorville, CA. 92395
